FREE GOLF LESSON OF THE MONTH.

A good putter thinks mainly of the force of his blow. The line of putt should be obvious after a few seconds consideration. Most putts miss on the score of length, not direction.

Consider the general conditions of the green, "hairiness" or fuzz requires more force than a freshly mown green, naturally, but it's amazing how often this is disregarded. Look at the grain of the grass along your line of putt. A sheen on the grass indicates the grain is with you; if there's none, then you'll need to overcome the extra resistance.
