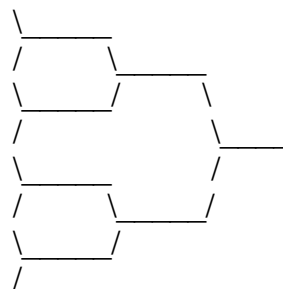
The results of our Jamberoo trip are shown later in the FOL & lizards are advised that Neil has booked for next year from Friday 7th March 2008.
