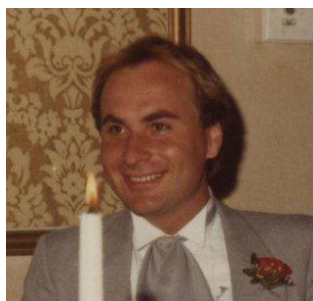


New visitor David Leonard started his Lizards career off in fine style with a countback win over the more regular Joel Prothero. Well done David – we hope to see more of you in the future.
