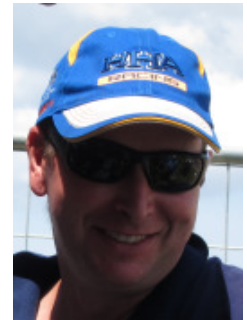
Hartmut Schwarz - **19** points off a handicap of **35**

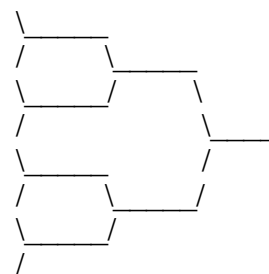
