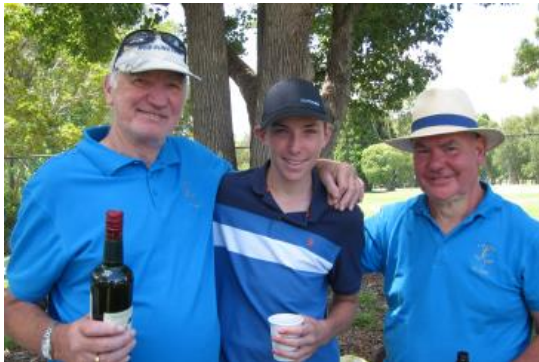
THE DENNIS CASTLE CHALLENGE, with 20 Lizards and 1 visitor, produced the following results:
