To make life easier for the Handicapper when it comes to determining the day's results in a timely manner (and with minimal stress), on the scorecard can you please:

- Swap cards with someone – that makes you 'the Marker'
- Complete:
 - The Date
 - The Marker's Name and Handicap
 - The Result
 - The Player's Signature
 - The Marker's Signature
- Make sure you put the Player strokes and score in the Player Column and the Marker strokes and score in the Marker Column
- Write legibly
- Add up the Player and Marker scores correctly
- Make sure the Player Total equals the Result
- You and your Marker agree on each other's Result
- If you're in a Lindenberg match:
 - Swap cards with your opponent
 - Keep track of the match. If you're 'all square' after 18 holes, you'll need to continue to the 19th, 20th, etc. until there is a result
 - Write the match result on top of the card

Frank Raso	His opponent in the prestigious Lindenberg comp gracefully accepting the advice and then duffing the shot

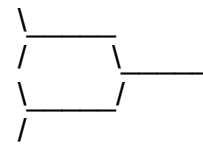
