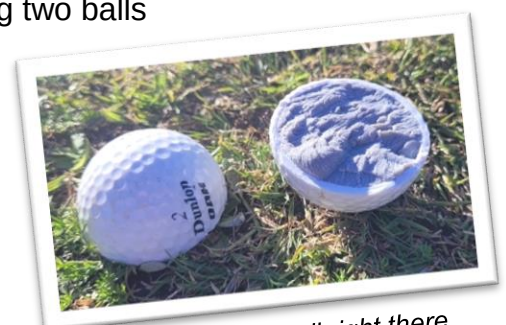
Other Business
