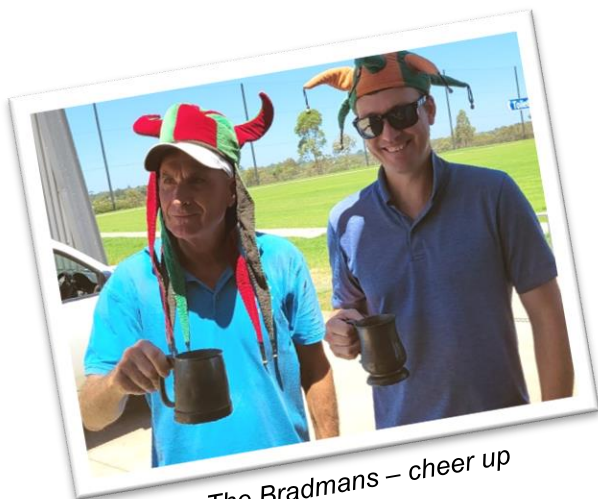
Jamberoo Trip

PUBLICANS FINED. Short Measure Beer.

At the Manly Police Court yesterday, Mr. Oram, S.M., fined several publicans for selling beer short of the measure purchased. Nigel Tipping, of the Deewhy Hotel, was fined £5, with 8/ costs. Inspector Joyce said that defendant sold a "pint" of beer, subsequently found to be four fluid ounces short. Philip Dunphy, of the Harbord Beach Hotel, on a similar charge, was fined £7, with 8/ costs. It was alleged that the measure contained only 13½ ounces. The Manly Hotels, Ltd., was ordered to pay a fine of £5, with 8/ costs. A "pint" of beer purchased in this instance, it was alleged, was 3½ ounces short.

On a charge of having for use an unstamped measure of capacity, Raymond Leon List was fined £1, with 8/ costs. Inspector Joyce said that the defendant, who was the licensee of the Steyne Hotel, sold a pint of beer, which was 4oz deficient. The capacity of the glass, which was unstamped, was 19½oz.

A pint is 20 fl.oz. (~570ml)
Leon was 21 ml short – shocking!
