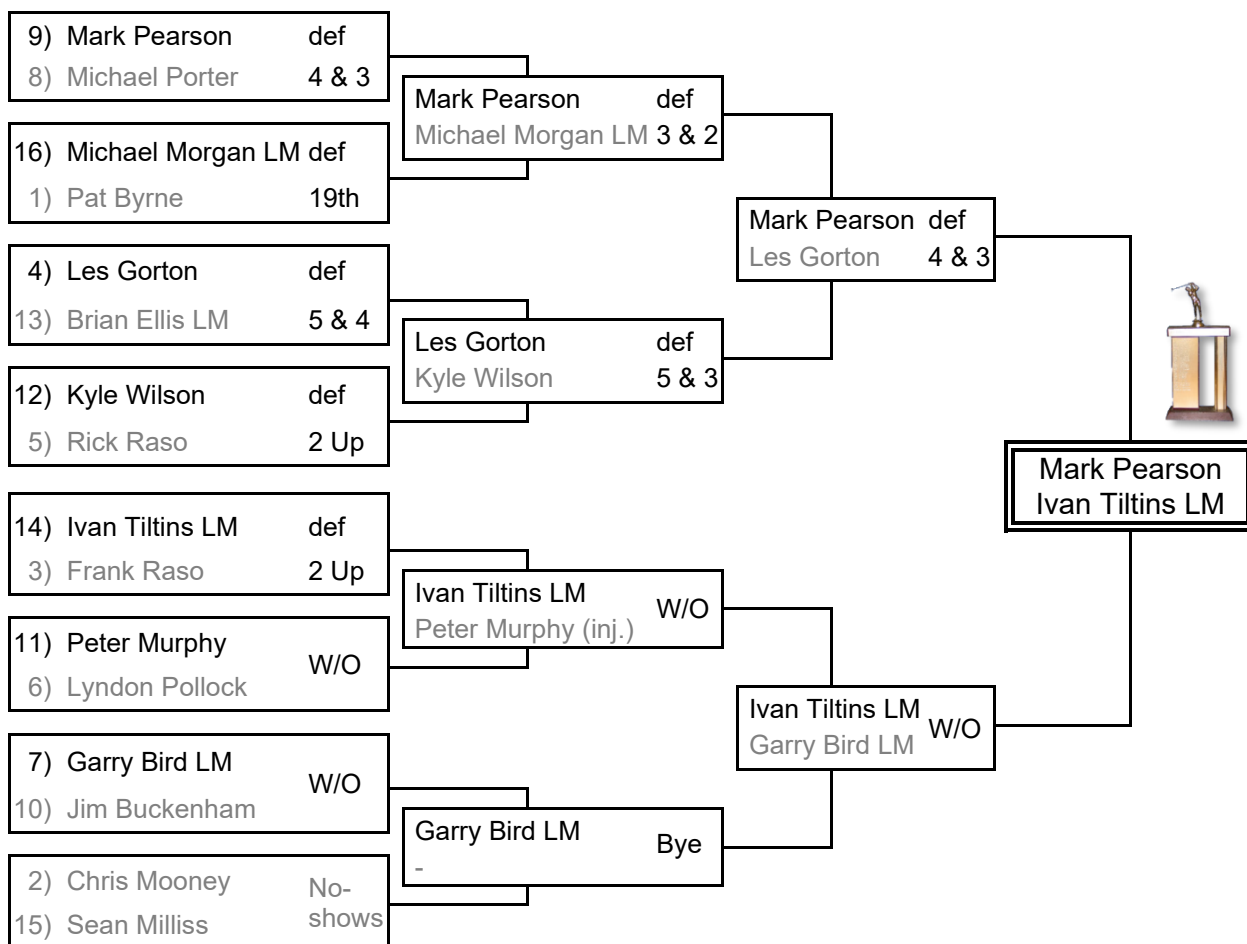

Vale Manfred Wagner LM

Manfred Wagner joined The Lizards in August 1995. He was President in 1998 and first took on the role of Captain/Handicapper the following year. His love of statistics saw him develop and refine the club's handicapping system – the same one we use today.

A chronic back condition stopped his playing days in their tracks in July 2004 however this didn't diminish his commitment to the club. Although he ceased being the match day handicapper he continued on as Assistant Handicapper until 2019, providing all of the handicap adjustments, printing of the scorecards and annual results for The Lizards. He continued adding features to his system as late as early 2025 despite having being diagnosed with Parkinson's Disease and later Motor Neuron Disease.

He sadly passed away on 24th May 2025 at Hornsby Hospital due to respiratory complications.
