Howard Lindenberg Trophy

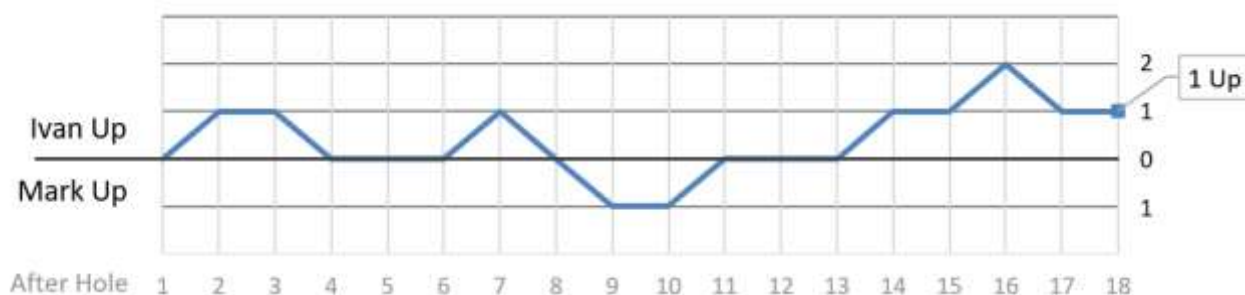
